COURSES FOR WOMEN including child care





Who is eligible to take part in a German language course?

Female migrants from Bad Homburg with little or no knowledge of the German language. Subject to course vacancies, women from the surrounding area are also welcome.

What do you learn in a German language course

The aim is to learn the German language for everyday use. Topics related to the child are covered as school, daycare, homework, parents' evenings, health and nutrition. Intercultural topics such as festivals in Germany and in the respective home country as well as behavioural patterns in the different cultures are also discussed and made comprehensible.

Course information

The courses are offered with 5-6 teaching units (45 minutes each) on different days (twice a week) in small groups and run all year round (except during the Hessian holidays).

The lecturers respond in a competent and playful way to the different learning levels of the women. Interested women can join at any time.

What does the course cost

- One lesson costs only € 1.50, with Bad-Homburg-Pass € 0.50 (please present Bad-Homburg-Pass upon registration)
- The course materials are free of charge.
